



Self-Employed Income Support Scheme (SEISS) update February 2021

On 3 March 2021 HMRC announced there would be a delay to the release of the 4th Self-Employed Income Support Scheme (SEISS) grant and the scheme will now open from late April and be available until 31 May 2021.

This is to allow HMRC time to process all self-assessment tax returns filed for 2019/2020 so that people who became self-employed during the 2019/2020 tax year will also be eligible to claim this 4th grant.
